HOW TO USE THIS INDEX

- Products in this index are organized by therapeutic categories. It is best to look at the condition, and then see what formulas are available.
- Using PDF Functions.
 - To search for a particular grouping, formula, or product on this PDF, you can use the Search function.
 - To search a grouping by page number, use the page number search in the bar menu.
 - Page size can be controlled by the percentage view in the bar menu.
- Classical formulas will be listed in *pinyin* and in italics, followed by a list of names and manufacturers that offer the classical formula. If a formula differs a little in terms of ingredients, that product will be followed by an asterisk (*).
- Products not based on a classical formula will be listed in the correct category, but apart from any classical antecedent.
- All products are followed by a code abbreviation of the manufacturer in parenthesis, listed below. “EG” refers to extract granules made in Taiwan, using the common English language name. “PM” refers to patent medicines.
- Specific therapeutic indications and herbal ingredients for each product are not included. These can be found in the product guides of each manufacturer.
- For therapeutic indications and herbal ingredients for the classical formulas, one can use any of the standard formula books, including:
 - Andrew Ellis, *Notes from South Mountain*, The Moon Publishing, Berkeley, 2003. (Good source for “Extract Granules from Taiwan.”)
 - Jake Fratkin, *Chinese Herbal Patent Formulas, The Clinical Desk Reference*, Shya Publications, 2001.
